
Orton Bradley Park



Short Walks from the Tearooms

All tracks are signposted, starting above the Tearooms



Camelia Walk: 10 mins return

A gentle climb through groups of Camelia bushes. This track joins the Dunmallet and Arboretum Tracks.

Rhododendron Walk: 20 mins return

A gentle stroll through the Rhododendron Society's collection of rhododendrons, Gentle climb to Adventure Playground and BMX Pump Track.

Arboretum Loop Walk: 40 mins return

This track leads across farmland and through a walnut grove to a collection of southern hemisphere beech trees. New Zealand Kauri and North American conifers. It is also home to the largest tree in New Zealand, a macrocarpa.

Dunmallet Loop Walk: 40 mins return

This hillside walk includes the Camelia and Rhododendron Walks and a collection of trees planted by Orton Bradley. Use this as a pleasant walk between the heritage buildings and the picnic areas.
